## Please note the following regarding the use of incense at St. Charles:

- ◆ There will be no incense used at the 5:00 p.m. Saturday Mass of Anticipation and the 7:15 a.m. Sunday morning Mass.
- ◆ There will be no incense used at the 6:00 p.m. Vigil and the 6:30 a.m. Masses on Holy Days of Obligation during the summer months (ex. Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15).
- ◆ There will be no incense used at all on Holy Days of Obligation that fall during the School Year due to the 8:30 a.m. All School Mass (ex. All Saints Day and Immaculate Conception).
- ◆ We will try to provide an incense-free environment for parishioners attending the 5:00 p.m. Mass of Anticipation on Saturday afternoons and the 6:00 p.m. Vigil Masses on Holy Days. However, if there is a funeral earlier on those days, there will be residual scent from the incense in the church, which takes about 24 hours to dissipate. (This residual scent may also affect the 7:15 a.m. Sunday Mass and the 6:30 a.m. Mass on Holy Days.)
